Use of shared commercial kitchen for ovens or stove cooking/heating:
\$100 per event during rental hours, and \$40/hr prior to event.

Prices shown are base rental rates. APEDF will determine charges based on the specific event factors such as the number of attendees, holidays, if the event is open to the public, etc. Akwaaba Hall does not host teen parties.

Rental hours include setup and breakdown time, the full time you will have access to the building. No entry or drop off of items prior to start time.

Renter is responsible for set up and breakdown of tables and chairs, (approx 100 chairs, ten 5' round and six 6' banquet tables) included in rental price.

PAYMENT POLICIES:

\$100 non-refundable, non-transferable Reservation Deposit is required to reserve the event date. The Reservation Deposit is applied toward rental fees.

All rental fees and a \$100 refundable security deposit must be paid in full 30 days prior to event.

If the event is less than 30 days away, all fees and refundable security deposit must be paid at time of booking.

HOLIDAY RATES:

MLKing Day, Memorial Day, Juneteenth, July 4, Labor Day, Thanksgiving, Christmas Eve and Day, New Years Eve and Day are rented at weekend evening rates. If the holiday falls on a weekend, add \$200 to the rental fee.
